

# New Family Life Center Guidelines for Parish Activities

We want to be better stewards of our St. Paul Parish properties, therefore we implemented a written policy for guidelines, expectations and protocol for use of the Family Life Center. This will prevent groups from not having a space to meet and rooms being "double booked." This will also help events run more smoothly as spaces will be cared for, maintained properly, and ready for immediate use. (No surprises like decorations, dirty dishes, or full trash cans left behind.)

Who? When?

This policy affects all persons and groups, within the Parish, and outside the Parish, who wish to use any room in the Family Life Center effective August 1, 2017. We will have separate policies for parish activities and outside activities, however parish activities will receive priority in the event of a scheduling conflict.

Everyone must make reservations to use any space of the Family Life Center facilities. including recurring meetings and events. Be mindful of reserving times to include set-up and clean-up times as needed, in addition to the time for the actual event.

To make a reservation, contact Cecilia Carlton, our Family Life Center Coordinator, by email at flc@saintpaulcatholicchurch.com, or call the office at 601-992-9547. Your event will be listed on the facilities calendar maintained by the St. Paul staff.

Procedures! All users will be required to sign a user agreement and follow all procedures and rules as defined in the new Family Life Center Guidelines.

All use of the Family Life Center kitchen will require a trained Kitchen Coordinator to be on site during the entire event. Kitchen Coordinator training will be held on Saturday, August 12, 2017 @ 9:00 am. Any parishioner is welcome to become a trained Kitchen Coordinator and be involved in assisting groups who hold events in the Family Life Center. We especially encourage each parish group to have at least 3-5 members become trained Kitchen Coordinators. We need several people in this role!
