**Clericalism** – a word I had to look up to define, only to find out it was something I was very familiar with. It had been a part of my faith always. Like a child looks to his father for guidance, the priest is our teacher to guide us in the way to our heavenly Father. The mission of Jesus Christ trickles down from the Pope through the Cardinals, bishops, priests and finally to the people or so it has been. Like all formal organizations there is a hierarchy that is necessary to preserve the mission so everyone doesn't go rogue.

The church has made me what I am. My mother was taught in a convent. I was taught in a school of predominantly nuns (my role models). I remember the Latin Mass and the murmurs among my classmates that the priest was going to face us for Mass! I also remember a trip to Spain in which a beautiful cathedral had been turned into a discotheque! So many grand cathedrals throughout Europe have turned into empty tombs for tourists to take pictures of.

Years ago, while working for a health insurance company, an insured called me asking for help with his bill. He had gone out-of-network for a heart procedure so we were only paying 70% but had he gone in network we would have paid 80%, problem is that his only option in network was a pacemaker for his heart while the out of network offered a surgical solution with no pacemaker. I went to the VP to ask that we honor 80% on his claim because I demonstrated that by going out of network this insured was saving our company a lot of money for years to come. Her response to me was "You think too much", and it was then I realized the mission was not to think, but to do as you are told. I succeeded in getting his bill reduced anyway.

Some 500 years ago Martin Luther acted out against clericalism, and today we are pondering what appears to be a similar question for perhaps a different reason. Is this just a means to save the Church? Are we going roque, or am I just thinking too much?


