DETACHMENT and the Gift of Contemplation

Last week, we read the Gospel account of Jesus visiting the home of Martha and Mary. Hopefully, we discovered the importance Jesus placed on the Virtue of Contemplation. On a surface-level reading of that Gospel, one could easily deduce that Jesus was scolding Martha for her busyness.

That certainly does not appear to be the intention of The Master. Rather, He was trying to bring to the fore a great truth in all of our lives — Don't let your busyness keep you from being a Contemplative. In other words, don't just be a "human doing," be a "human being!" Be in harmony with your Creator and provide an opportunity to become aware that He lives within!

With a superficial glance at this Gospel, it may appear that Mary's part was the easier one — all she had to do was sit there — and Martha's was the hard part. But, as one reflects more deeply on the passage it is easy to see Mary's part was much more difficult. It is not easy to set aside one's own work and give your undivided attention to another. Our world tends to regard busyness whether it is accomplishing some goal or not.

The real message of the Gospel may be that it is very easy to become frenetic with action and important things to do; so much so that we forget our Creator. We forget the source of our being and the purpose of our work.....the purpose of our lives! Our work and service of others can become shallow, and ultimately meaningless, and our religion sterile and hollow, unless it is connected to Him.

John Henry Newman wrote the following in one of his great sermons:

Perhaps the reason why the standard of holiness among us is so low, why our attainments are so poor, our view of the truth so dim, our belief so unreal, our general notions so artificial and external is this, that we dare not trust each other with the secret of our hearts. We have each the same secret, and we keep it to ourselves, and we fear that, as a cause of estrangement, which really would be a bond of union. We do not probe the wounds of our nature thoroughly; we do not lay the foundation of our religious profession in the ground of our inner man; we make clean the outside of things; we are amiable and friendly to each other in words and deeds, but our love is not enlarged, our bowels of affection are straightened, and we fear to let the intercourse begin at the root; and in consequence, our religion, viewed as a social system, is hollow.

The presence of Christ is not in it. (Sermon 9, Christian Sympathy)


3rd Annual Early Learning Center Golf Tournament

CONTEMPLATIVE PRAYER

We may think of prayer as thoughts or feelings expressed in words. But this is only one expression. In the Christian tradition contemplative prayer is considered to be the pure gift of God. It is the opening of mind and heart — our whole being — to God, the Ultimate Mystery, beyond thoughts, words and emotions. Through grace we open our awareness to God whom we know by faith is within us, closer than breathing, closer than thinking, closer than choosing, closer than consciousness itself.

CENTERING PRAYER

Centering Prayer is a method designed to facilitate the development of contemplative prayer by preparing our faculties to receive this gift. It presents ancient Christian wisdom teachings in an updated form. Centering prayer is not meant to replace other kinds of prayer; rather it casts a new light and depth of meaning on them. It is at the same time a relationship with God and a discipline to foster that relationship. This method of prayer is a movement beyond conversation with Christ to communion with Him.

WISDOM SAYING OF JESUS

Centering Prayer is based on the wisdom saying of Jesus in the Sermon on the Mount: "when you pray, go to your inner room, close the door and pray to your Father in secret. And your Father, who sees in secret, will reward you." (Mt 6:6) It is also inspired by writings of major contributors to the Christian contemplative heritage including John Cassian, the anonymous author of <u>The Cloud of Unknowing</u>, Francis de Sales, Teresa of Avila, John of the Cross, Therese of Lisieux, and Thomas Merton.
