"If what being Catholic means to you is just going to Sunday Mass and not eating meat on Fridays during Lent, you can stop reading right now."

This sentence certainly caught my attention! Naturally, it made me want to read on further, regardless of whether this was my idea of being Catholic or not. Such a stark sentence did bring an array of questions flooding into my mind.

Is it possible to adhere to such a minimalist's perspective and be Catholic? Are there people who really fit into this category? Wow! What a thought!

The sentence was the opening greeting in a letter I received from the *National Catholic Reporter (NCR)* inviting me to renew my subscription for the next year or two. While the opening greeting stymied me, that is just what it was supposed to do – so, it was successful!

The letter continued: "But if you think being Catholic has something to do with the decisions you make on a daily basis and the influence you have on those around you, you probably want to continue reading. And if you believe being Catholic means leading the way in building a more just society by bringing Catholic values to bear in important discussions on the issues, you definitely want to keep reading.

"The National Catholic Reporter (NCR) is an essential tool for Catholics who care about the Church and believe that all voices, including their own, are essential to the Church's wellbeing."

Wow! That is a powerful statement! I have been trying to say as much in the past five years — Your voice is important in the Church, at least here in St. Paul Catholic Church! Remember, five years ago I asked you to write me and answer this question, "How are we going to be Church here at St. Paul?" I still have a folder full of your thoughts and perspectives, which I check on every now and then to see if we have worked on implementing your recommendations.

We have done a good job of implementing all you have given us, so far. But, there is so much more to do --- to say --- to implement --- to practice --- to put into place --- to move beyond being "Catholics who just go to Mass on Sunday and refrain from eating meat on Fridays during Lent!"
