During these summer months, the offices of Adult Education and Faith Formation are busy planning and preparing for the upcoming 2017–2018 school year. We are happy to announce the installation of the Level 3 Catechesis of the Good Shepherd atrium. We will now be able to offer this program in its entirety and provide the children of our parish, ages 3 years through 6th grade the complete Catechesis of the Good Shepherd experience. This has been a labor of love for a number of years requiring over 300 hours of training. We thank all those who have supported this process and invite you to come by and visit an atrium and observe your children learning and experiencing the love of Jesus in these sacred environments. Catechesis of the Good Shepherd will continue to meet on Sunday mornings from 9:15–10:15am, between the masses. We also offer a **Children's Liturgy during the 10:30 mass**. Children are invited by Father Hurley to hear the Word and participate in a small group setting. Children, ages 2–5, are escorted into the Level I atrium by adult volunteers and receive the readings on their level. This is just another great opportunity for our younger children to experience the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd setting.

Our youth group, The Big Deal, (grades 7-12) meets on Wednesday evenings from 6:00-8:30pm. During this time together they share a meal, participate in large group Praise and Worship, and have grade level instruction & small groups. They also gather for various other recreational and service opportunities throughout the year. The Big Deal is under the guidance of Cory Head, our Youth Director.

As we have talked about many times, parents are the main teachers of the faith for their children. They are most influenced by the example you set for your family. If they see that regular mass attendance and participation in parish life are important to you, then it will be important to them. As we continue to move our parish from **maintenance to mission**, one of our priorities will be to focus on sacramental preparation and the intent and expectations of the parents as well as the students. Children are expected to be participating in religious formation throughout their school years. However, at least two years of consecutive instruction is required prior to receiving the sacraments of first communion and confirmation. 
