Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time



Father Gerry, your request for thoughts on clericalism strikes me as a loaded question. A few weeks ago the bulletin quoted Merriam Webster's definition of clericalism as "a policy of maintaining or increasing the power of a religious hierarchy." Parsing the definition, should we first examine whether "a religious hierarchy" is good or not? Or, more broadly, should we examine whether "the POWER of a religious hierarchy" is good or not? If this power or this hierarchy is good, then maintaining or increasing it seems noble. But, if the power or the hierarchy is not good, then surely maintaining or increasing it cannot be good.

But, I sense the question is better framed, that since some religious hierarchy is inevitable, is our present maintenance or increasing the hierarchy appropriate or misguided? Should it be maintained? Are we satisfied with it? Or, does the hierarchical structure allow for unintended, negative consequences?

We benefit from order and structure, because after all, we are sheep in desperate need of the Good Shepherd and priests and bishops who help show us the Way. But, we are gifted with minds and hearts and that itching sensation called free will, allowing us to choose our course of action. When we choose to follow Jesus and act accordingly, we honor Him.

On the other hand, to the extent, we opt out of the decision, deferring to others (even priests and bishops) to decide for us, we run the risk of neglecting to exercise our free will to follow Jesus ourselves. In other words, passivity or deference may equate to neglect. And, neglect is a choice, a choice of inaction...and not a good one.

I see clericalism like a gift. The laity give the clerics the power to act. When that gift is accompanied with concurrent prayer and responsiveness to God, the clerics lead well. When that gift does not contain corresponding prayer, the priests and bishops are entrusted with power...power to lead the passive, the neglectful. True servant leaders don't want that kind of power. True servant leaders want to lead co-servants, co-heirs of the Kingdom, fellow laborers, yoked in prayer. We parishioners at St. Paul have this type of leader, for which we are thankful.

May we jointly labor to serve and honor the Most High God.


