## LEADERSHIP - KINGSHIP

As we come to the end of our Liturgical Year and celebrate the truth that Jesus Christ is our King — our President, if you like since we are not under a monarchy in the U.S. — But, what does that mean?

The history of the feast dates back to Pope Pius XI in 1925. The observance in the Roman Church was moved in 1970 to the final Sunday in Ordinary Time. Therefore, the earliest Sunday it could be celebrated is November 20th, and the latest is November 27th. When the Revised Common Lectionary was publicly released in 1994 after a nine-year trial period, the Anglican, Lutheran, and many other Protestant Faiths were observing the Feast of Christ the King on the same Sunday, the last Sunday of the Liturgical Year.

## So, what does this Feast mean in my life?

- What difference does it make that Jesus Christ is my King?
- Or, more importantly let's ask the question Is Jesus Christ really my King?
- What evidence do I have that can substantiate that?
- How does it manifest itself in my life?
- Would people know by the way I live my life that Jesus Christ is my Lord and King?

## Do I live like royalty — as a Son or Daughter of the King?

- Who guides me and leads me on this special journey?
- Do I have a spiritual guide who assists me in reflecting honestly on my life?
- ☆Where am I going? Why am I going there?
- What behaviors do I need to change, adjust, or alter? What do I need to let go of in order for me to live "The Abundant Life" that my Lord and King has in mind for me?
- ☆Who is my coach? Is he/she guiding me effectively?
- Am I open and honest enough with my coach that they can help me be the best I can be as a Son/Daughter of the King?






