Oscar Romero's LEADERSHIP

Oscar Romero served as the fourth archbishop of San Salvador. He became a very powerful leader in a corrupt and violent government. He spoke out against poverty, social injustice, assassinations, and torture.

During his beatification, Pope Francis stated, "His ministry was distinguished by a particular attention to the most poor and marginalized." Oscar Romero became the embodiment of the Catholic people of El Salvador. Even outside of Catholicism, Romero is honored through the Calendar of Common Worship by other Christian denominations, including the Church of England, Anglican, and Lutheran.

On March 24, 1980, Romero was assassinated while offering Mass in the Chapel of the Hospital of Divine Providence.


