Here is a great story:

THE HOSPITAL WINDOW

As the man by the window described all this exquisite detail, the man on the other side of the room would close his eyes and imagine the picturesque scene.

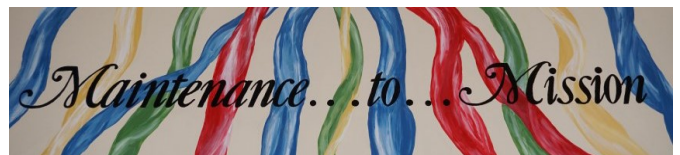
